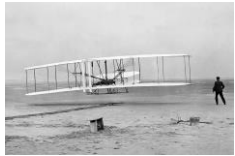

Key vocabulary
Achievement: something done successfully through hard work or courage.

Evidence: the information that historians take from sources.

Eyewitness account: A written record or audio recording of someone who witnessed an event.

primary source: an original document from the period being studied that has not been changed in any way.

Historically significant: an important person or event from history.
